Ladder of Communication

Following is a general guideline to follow for communication within the Falcon Football Family. This is a step-by-step procedure that needs to be followed in a chain of command.

Issues will not be addressed unless they have followed the appropriate protocols. If at any time you believe an issue is important or would be considered an emergency, then you should communicate directly with Coach Maxwell.



Ladder of Communication

1. Player to Captain

- Small issues regarding themselves and/or between players
- Future plans (schedule)

2. Player to Position Coach

- Strategy/concepts/skills questions
- How can I improve?

3. Player to Head Coach

- Important issues concerning themselves and/or the team
- How can I improve?
- Questions regarding behavior guidelines
- Attendance
- Injuries
- Future plans (schedule)

4. Parent to Head Coach

Concern for their child

Practice Protocols (cont.)

- If you are injured & cannot practice, you are still expected to be at every practice and team activity. <u>Put your practice jersey on</u> and contribute mentally.
- If you see a doctor and are ruled out of participation, you must have a signed doctors note turned into Sarah before you are allowed to participate again. (Follow Concussion Protocol w/Ben: Doctor's note, return to play)

- Cost: \$570 (Sm-Large) or \$590 (XL)






