Typical Season – High Level

Spring Workouts

February – May

- » After school weights for incoming Freshmen
- » Gervais Training: Sunday Mornings (FGIC sponsored)

Summer Practices

June 3rd – July 31st

- » Typically M,T,Th,F at WHS (calendar released late March)
- » Morning weights and/or practices
 - WIAA Practice Rules: 17 Practices (5 without pads & 12 with pads)
- » Includes CWU Camp and July Mini Camp
- » 100% participation encouraged – all prep for fall season



Typical Season – High Level (cont)

Vacation Window

August 1st – 11th

Fitness Testing

Starts week of August 12th

- » If families are gone this week communicate with the coaches for makeup.

Fall Football Season

Starts August 21st – 100% Participation MANDATORY. Players will not be able to participate in other sports at this time.

- » Kick off training with the 44Strong Camp 8/21-8/24
- » Practice is every day except Sundays in order to be eligible to play by the first game
- » C-Team kick off Jamboree – tentatively Sept 7th
- » C Team Games are typically Wednesday nights, first game tentatively 9/11
- » FGIC Auction Saturday Sept 14th (tentative)

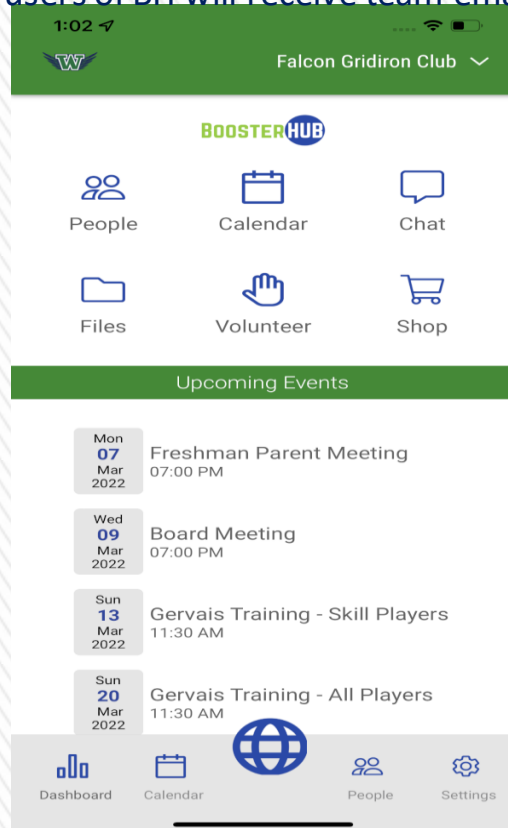

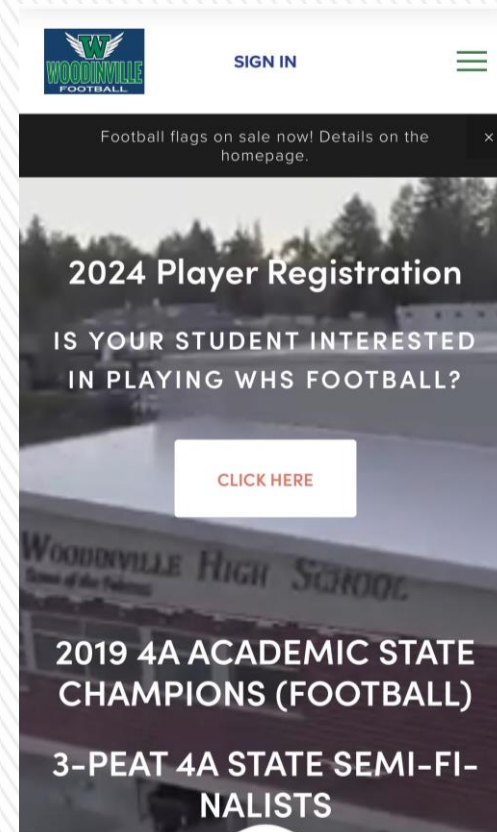
Used for FGIC registration, dues and donation payments, one-off sales, communication, and member chat. Requires a log in. Only registered users of BH will receive team emails.

Communication

BoosterHub is used to communicate to members (parents and players)

- » 95% of communication to families will come from the Secretary via email (Monday Updates).

BAND is used by Coaches and Players to communicate to each other.

- » Parents do NOT have access to Band.
- » Parents are encouraged to ask their player for updates before contacting the FGIC
- » Coaches will share practice schedules and expectations with the players directly.
- » Band is invite only from upperclassman player
